What will we accomplish?

Our goal is to create a safe school environment—a place where students are empowered with the coping skills necessary to deal with conflict in a respectful manner.



What are we doing?

Implement **Aggression Replacement Training** at Lenihan Intermediate School, Miller Middle School, Marshalltown High School, and the Marshalltown Learning Academy. The ART curriculum equips students with empathy, anger control, and pro-social skills.

Select and implement an evidence-based **anti bullying curriculum** for students in grades K-6.

Complete a **safety audit** of all district buildings to improve student safety and building security.

How are we doing?

<i>Goal</i>	<i>2010</i>	<i>2011</i>
The % of students in grades 6, 8, and 11 who did not go to school on 1 or more days because they felt unsafe at school or on their way to school will decrease	9.8%	
The % of students who report they have been threatened with a weapon on school property will decrease.	6.7%	
The % of students involved in a physical fight on school property will decrease.	14.3%	
The % of students who report being left out of things on purpose, excluded from their group of friends, or completely ignored will decrease.	21.9%
